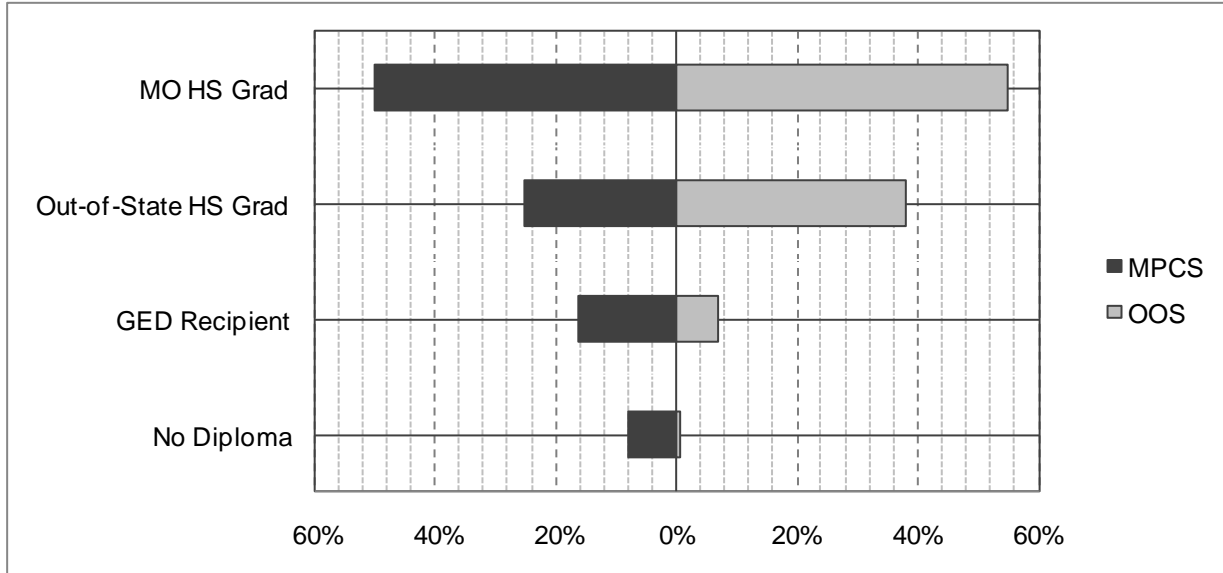

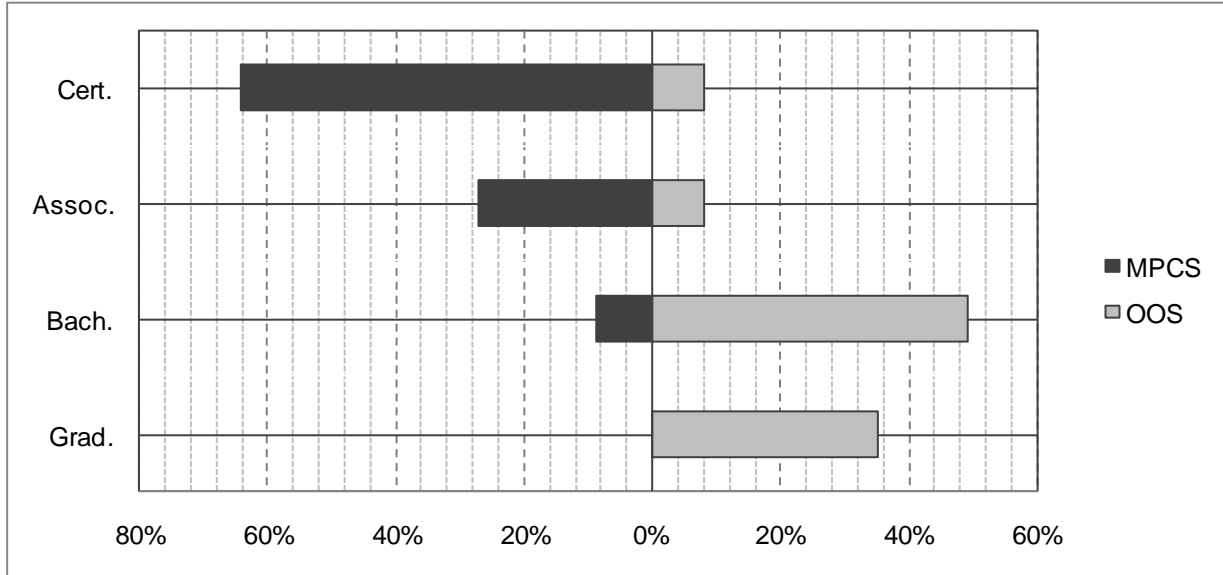

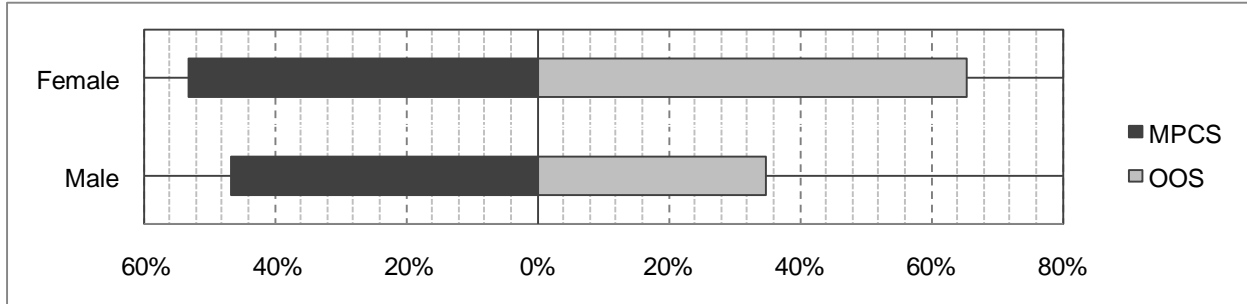

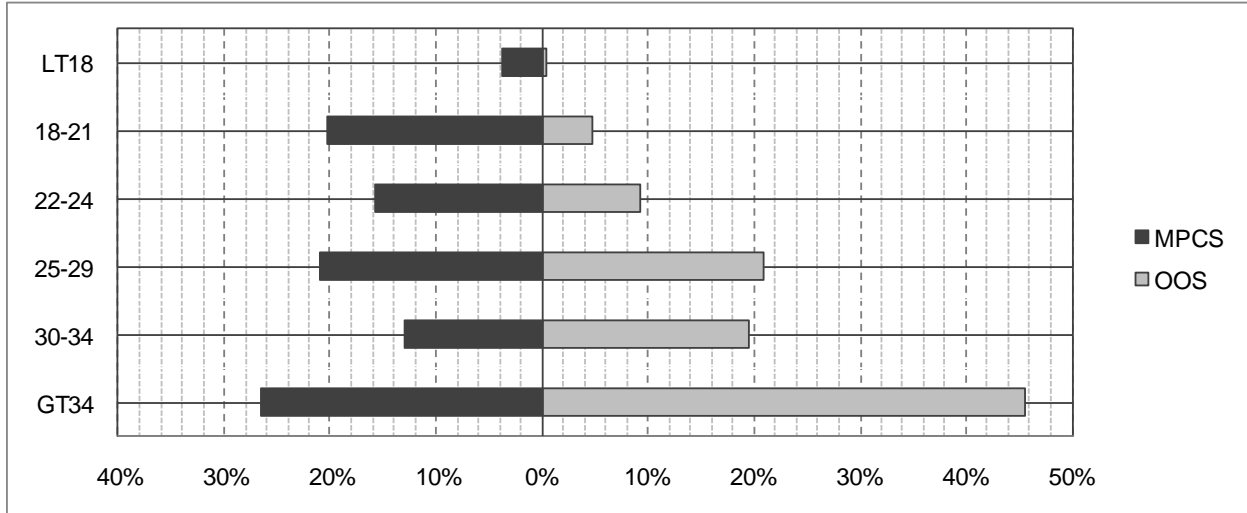

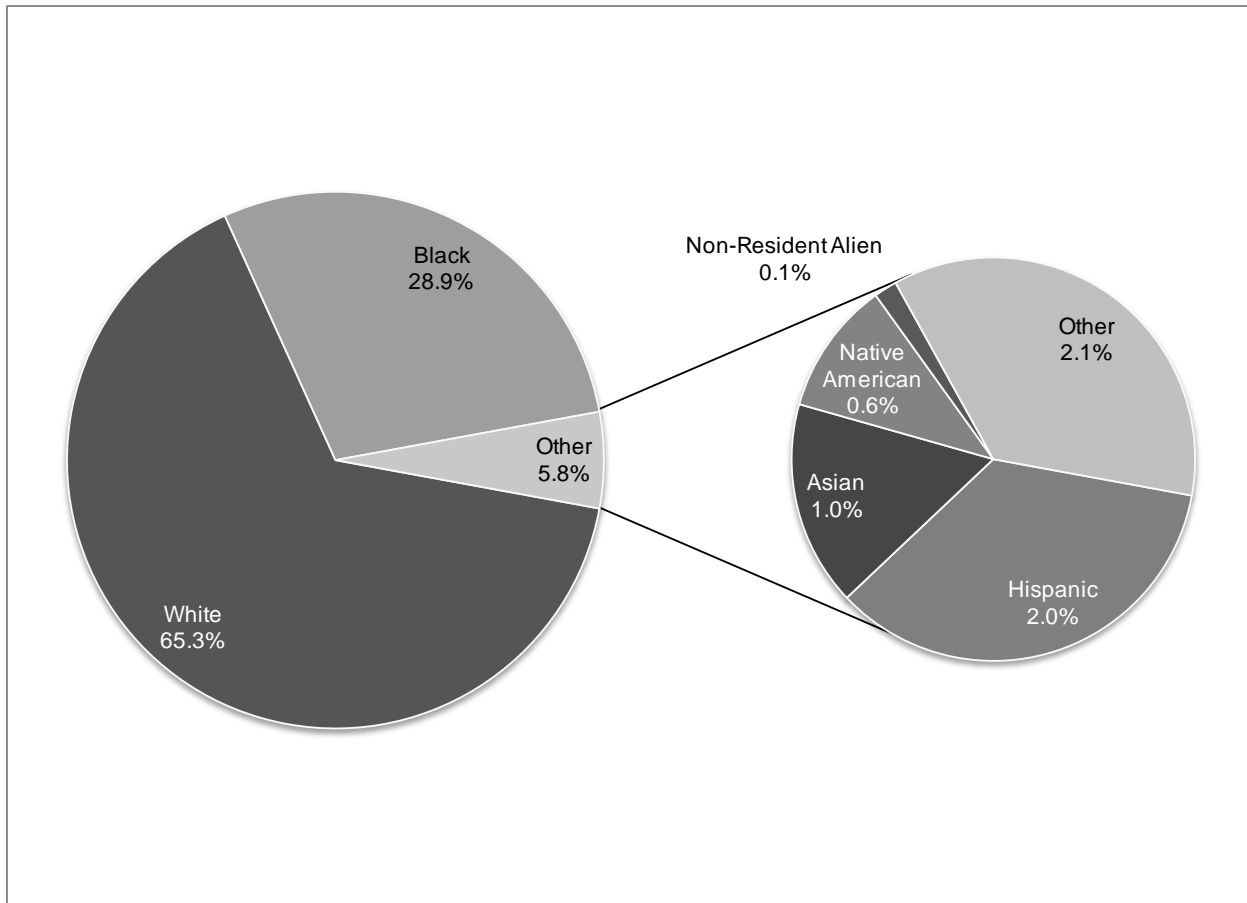

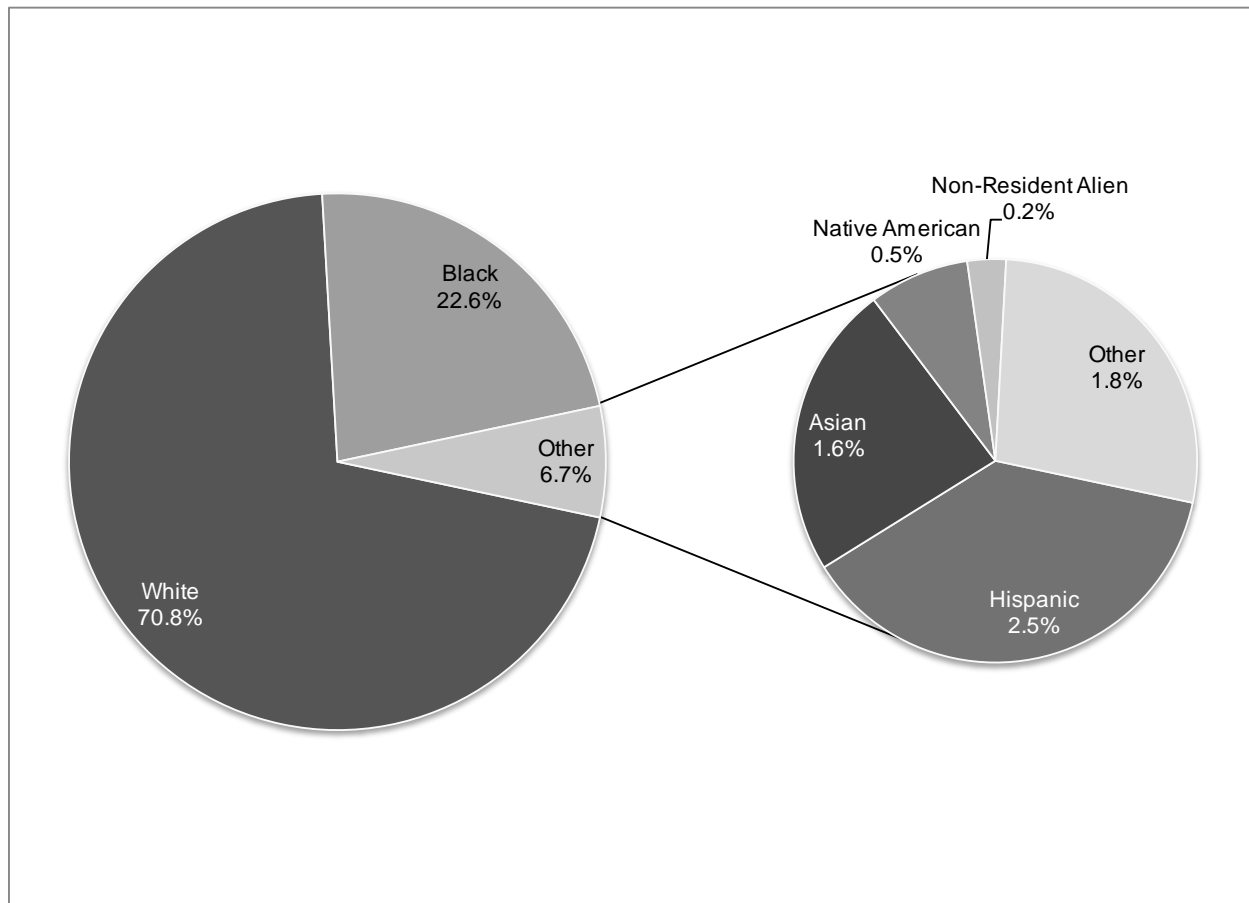

Out-of-State Regionally Accredited Degree-Granting Institutions



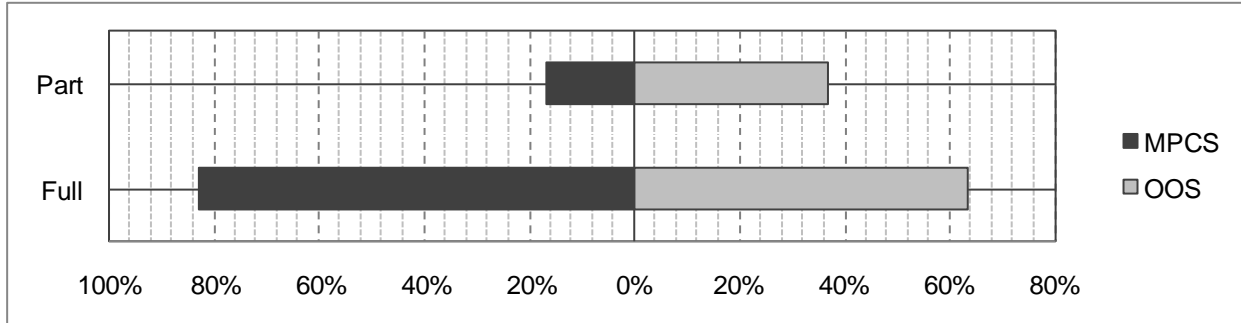

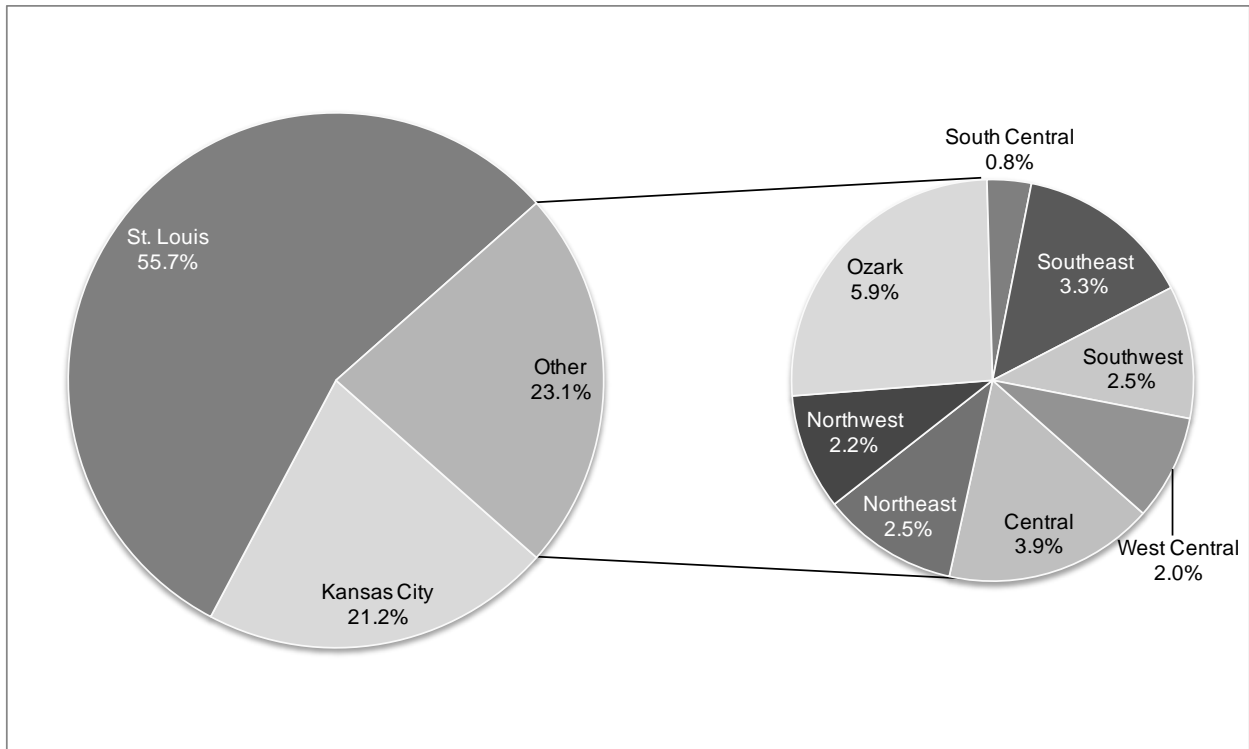

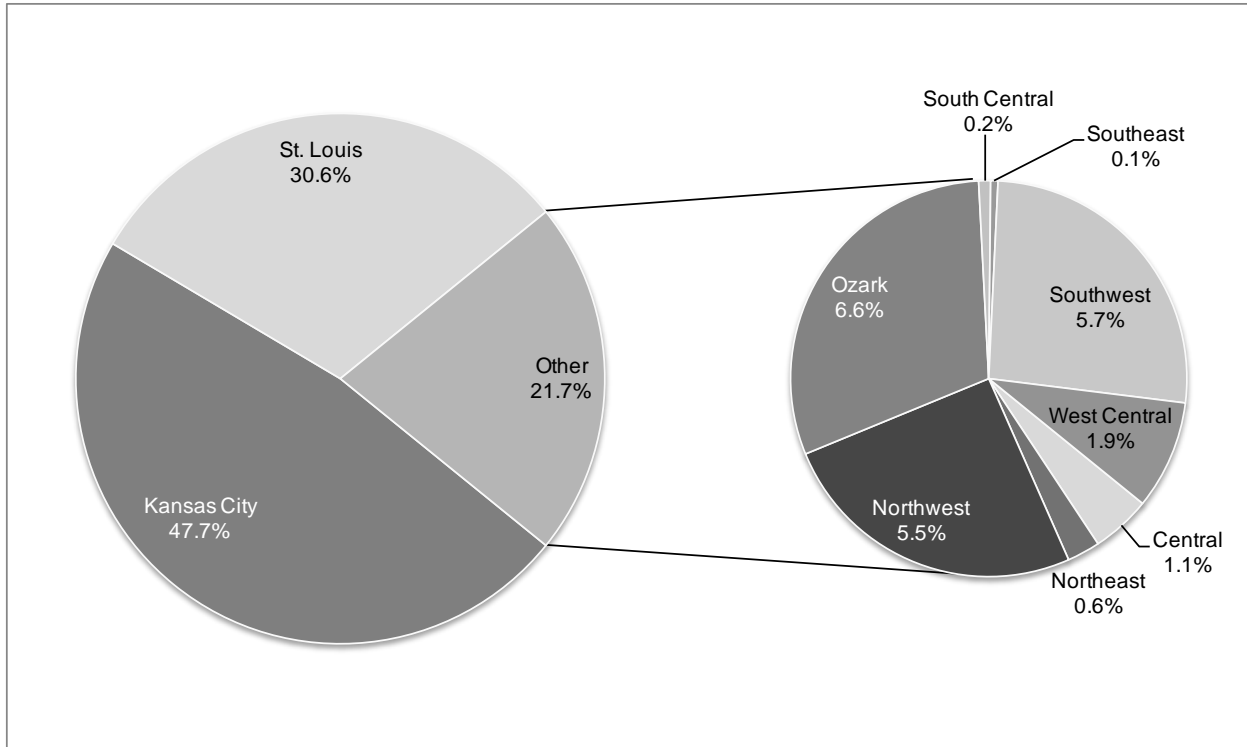

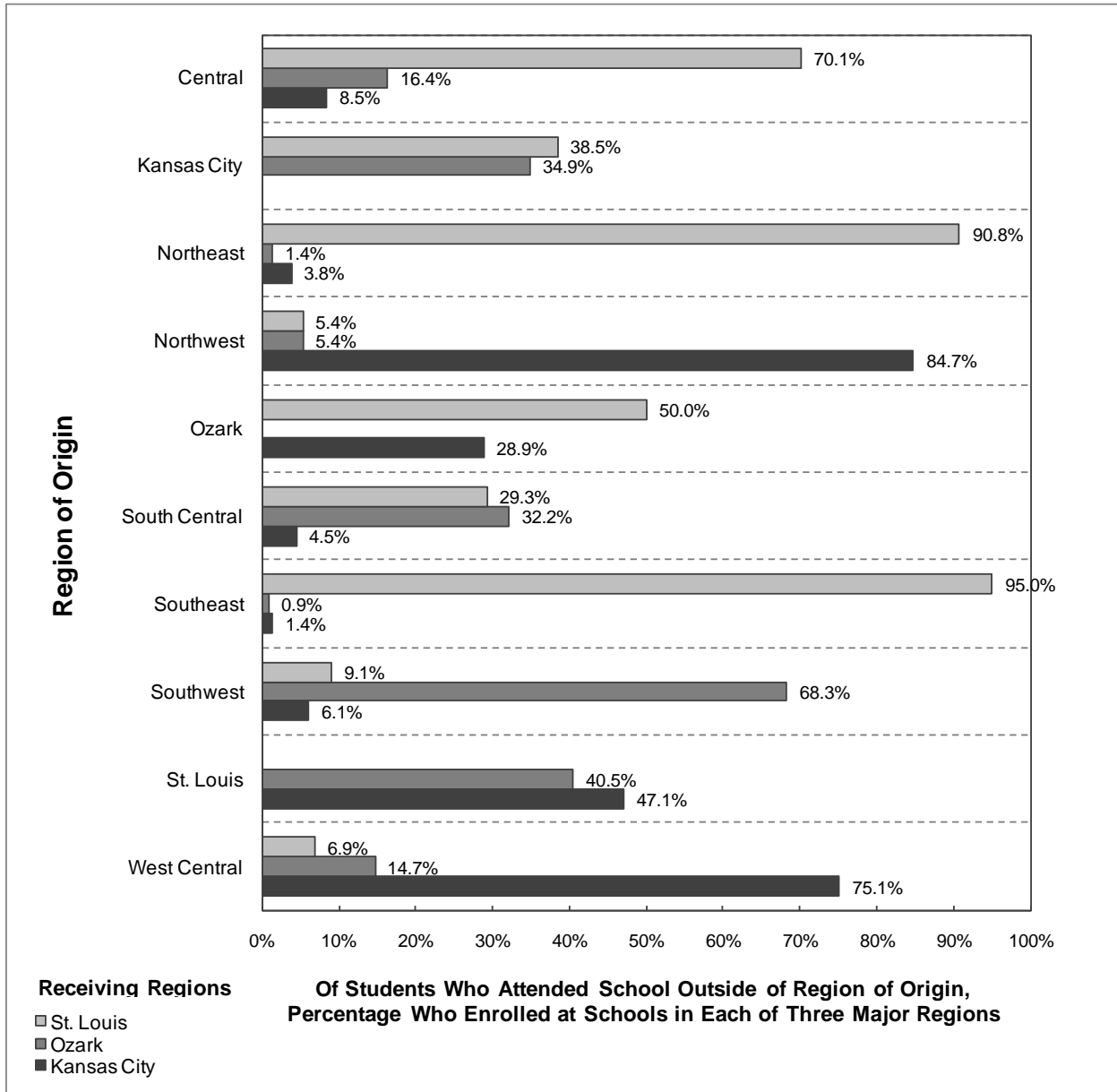

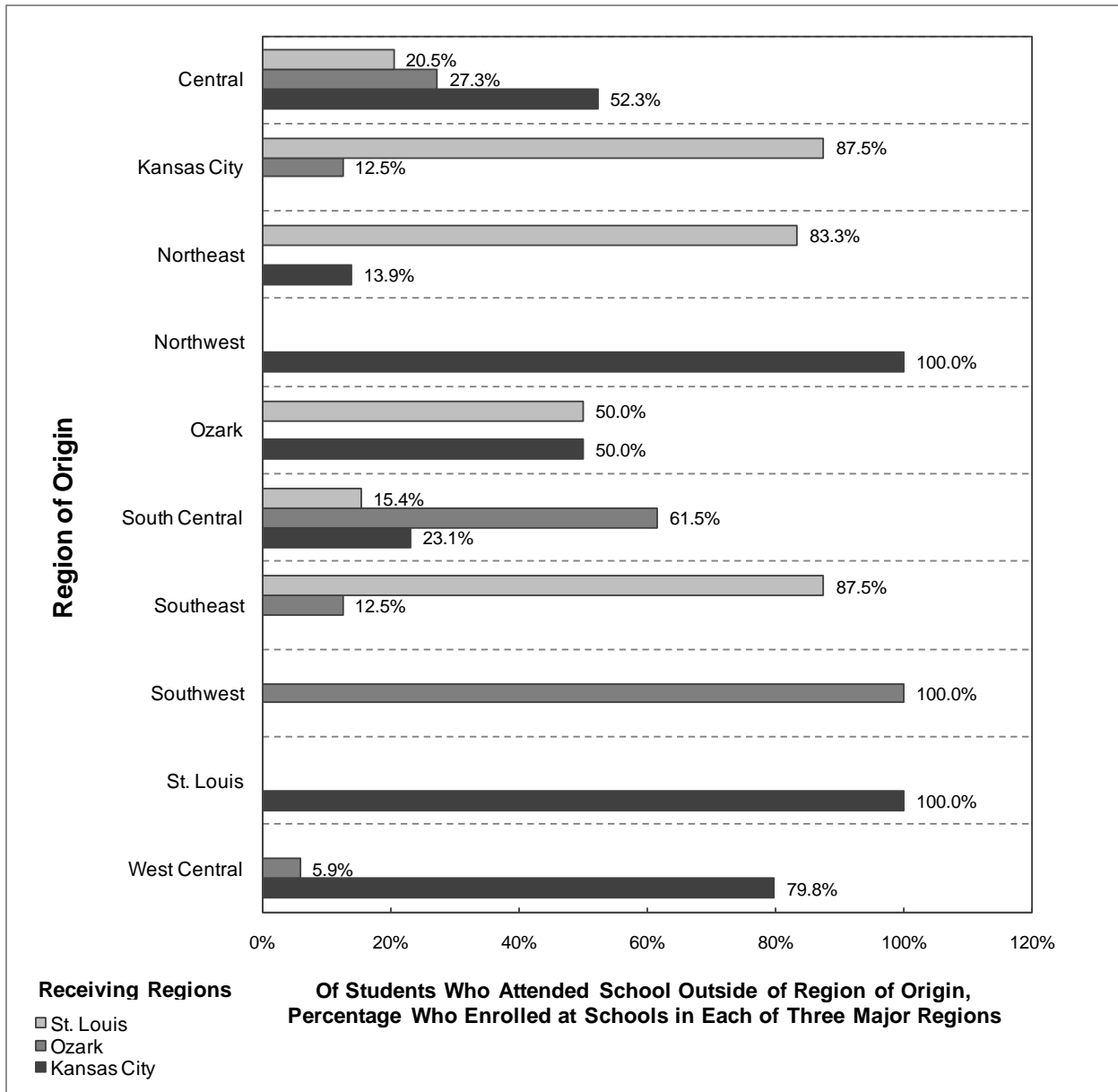

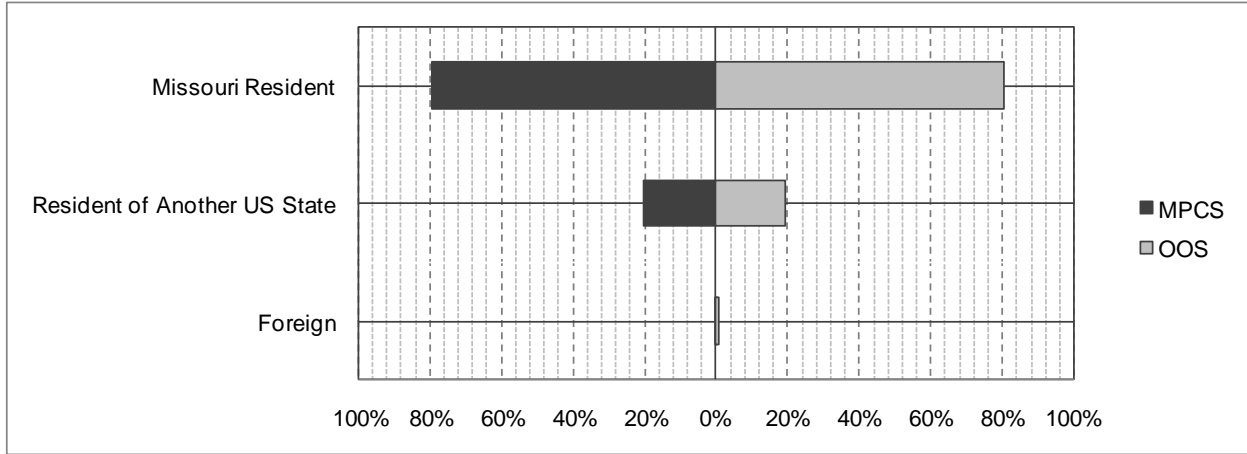

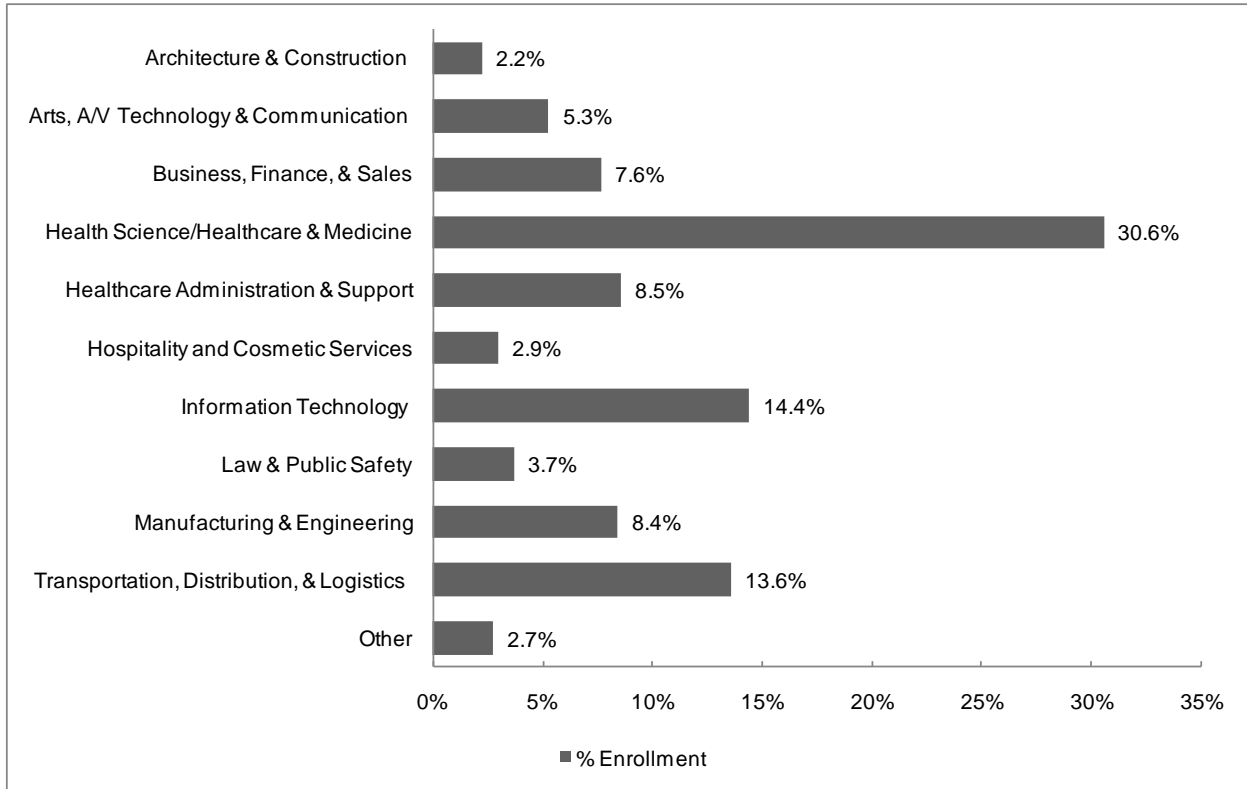

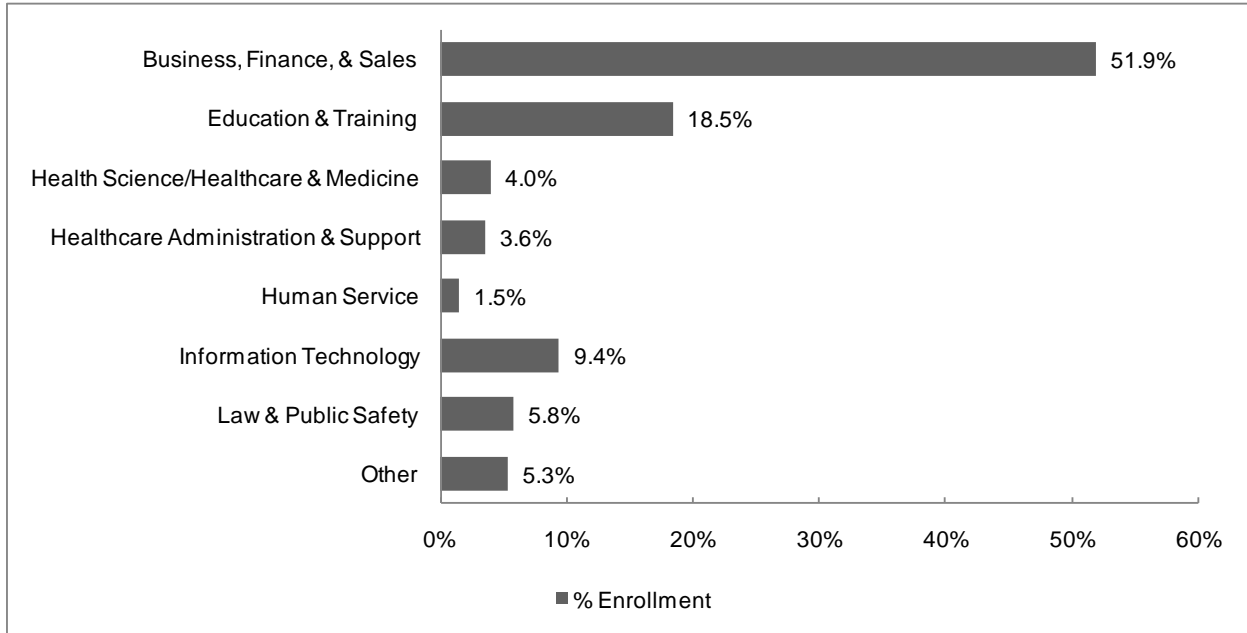

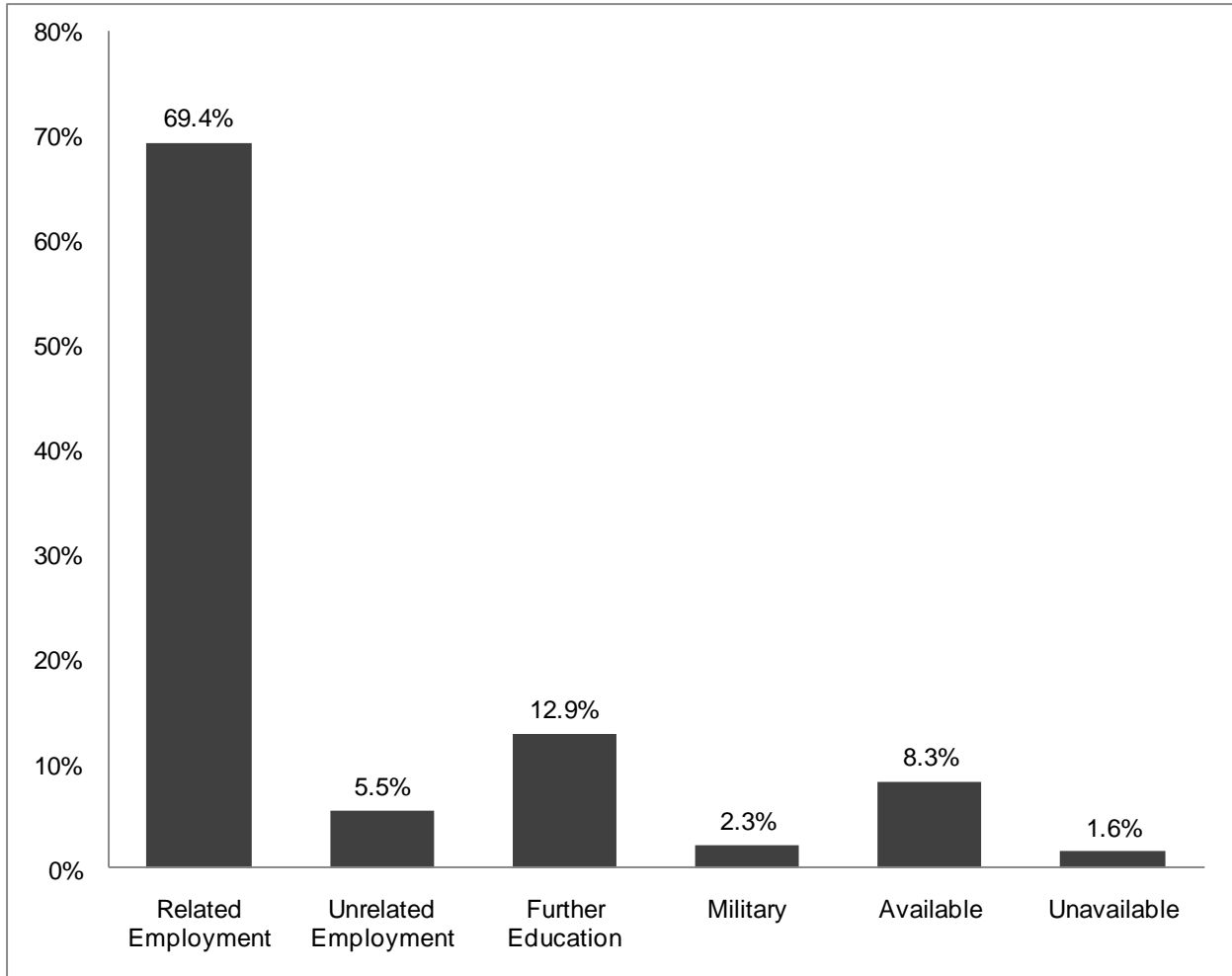

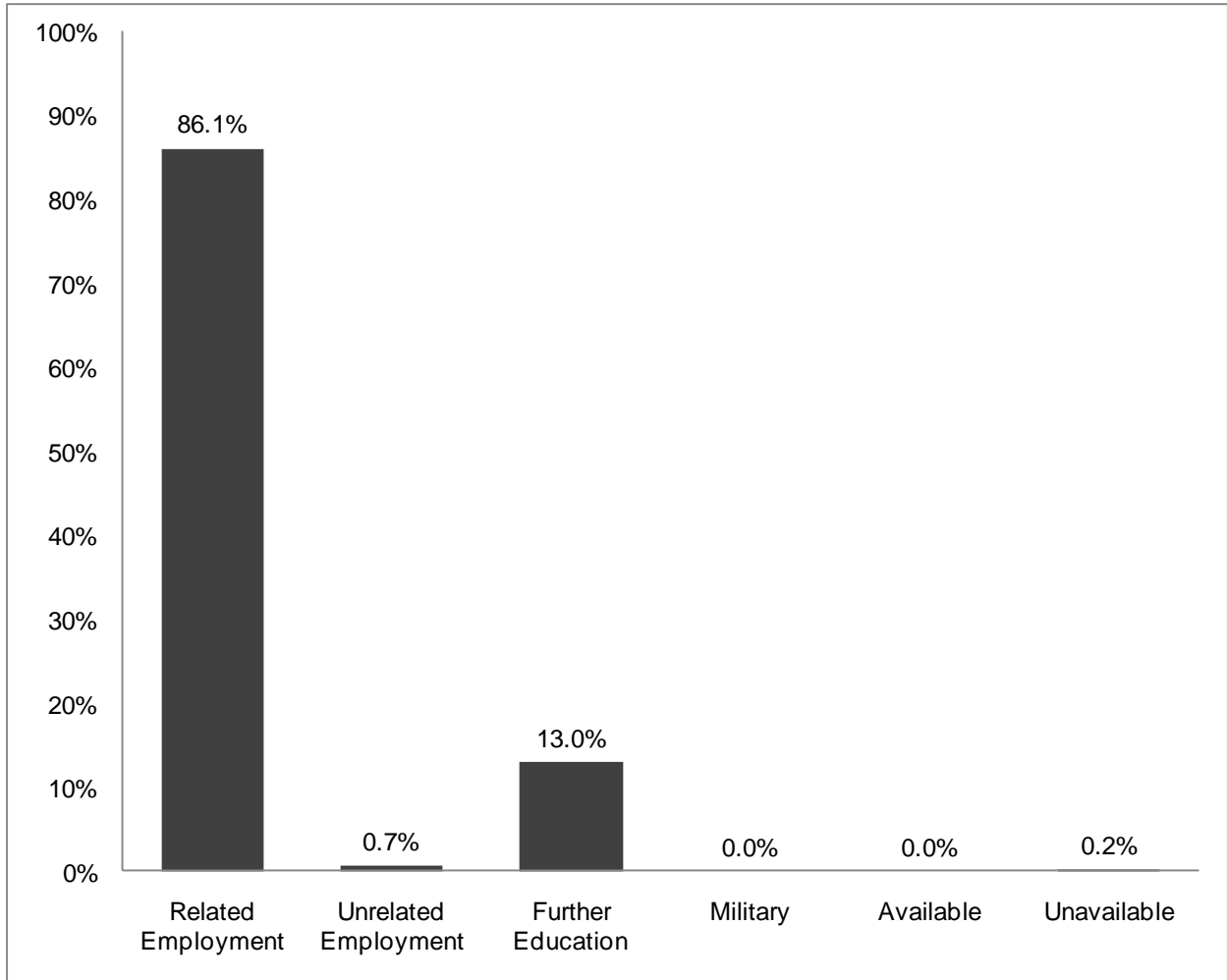

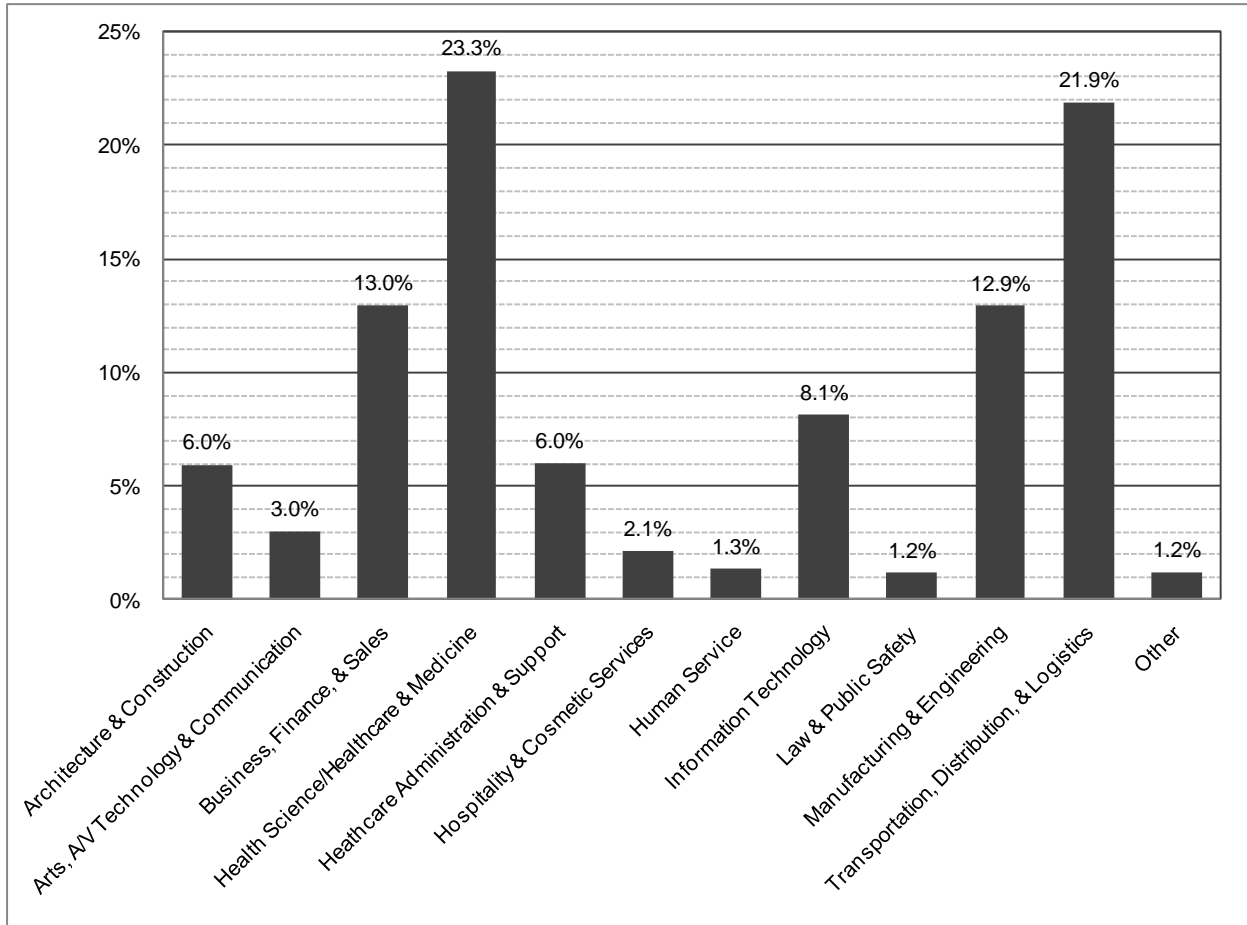

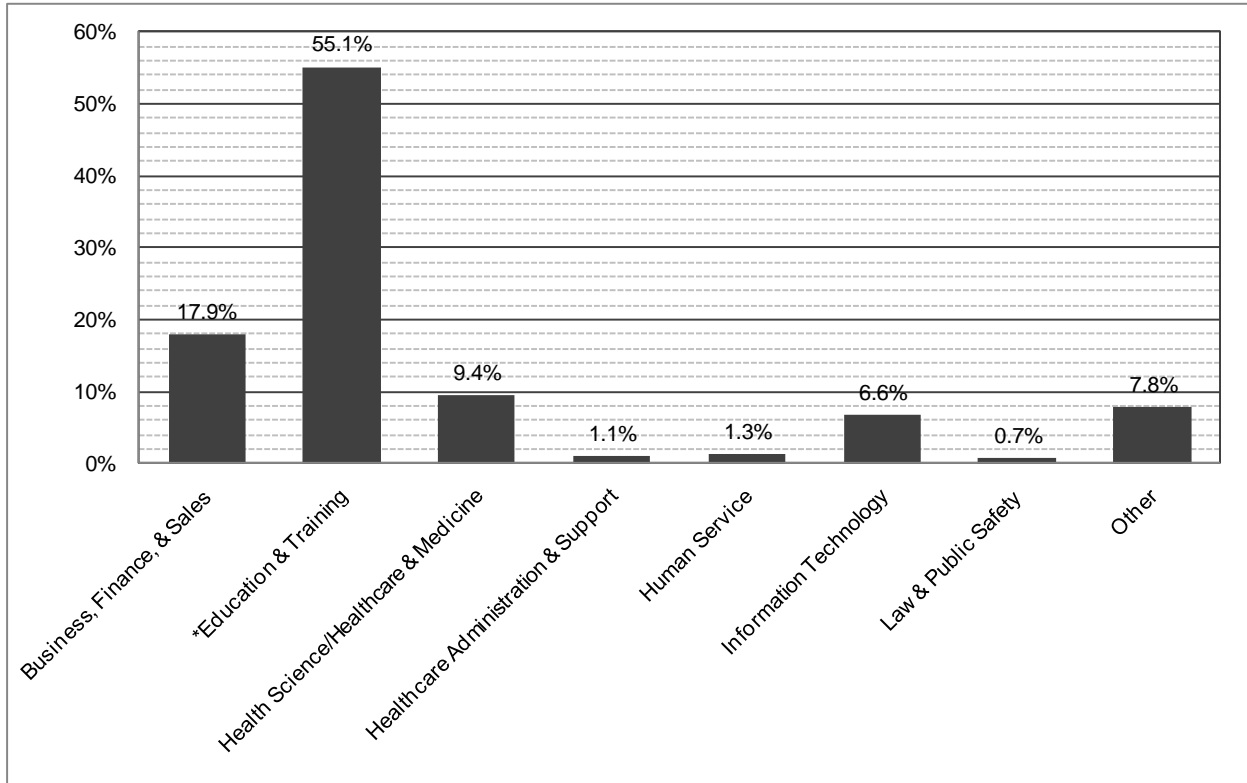

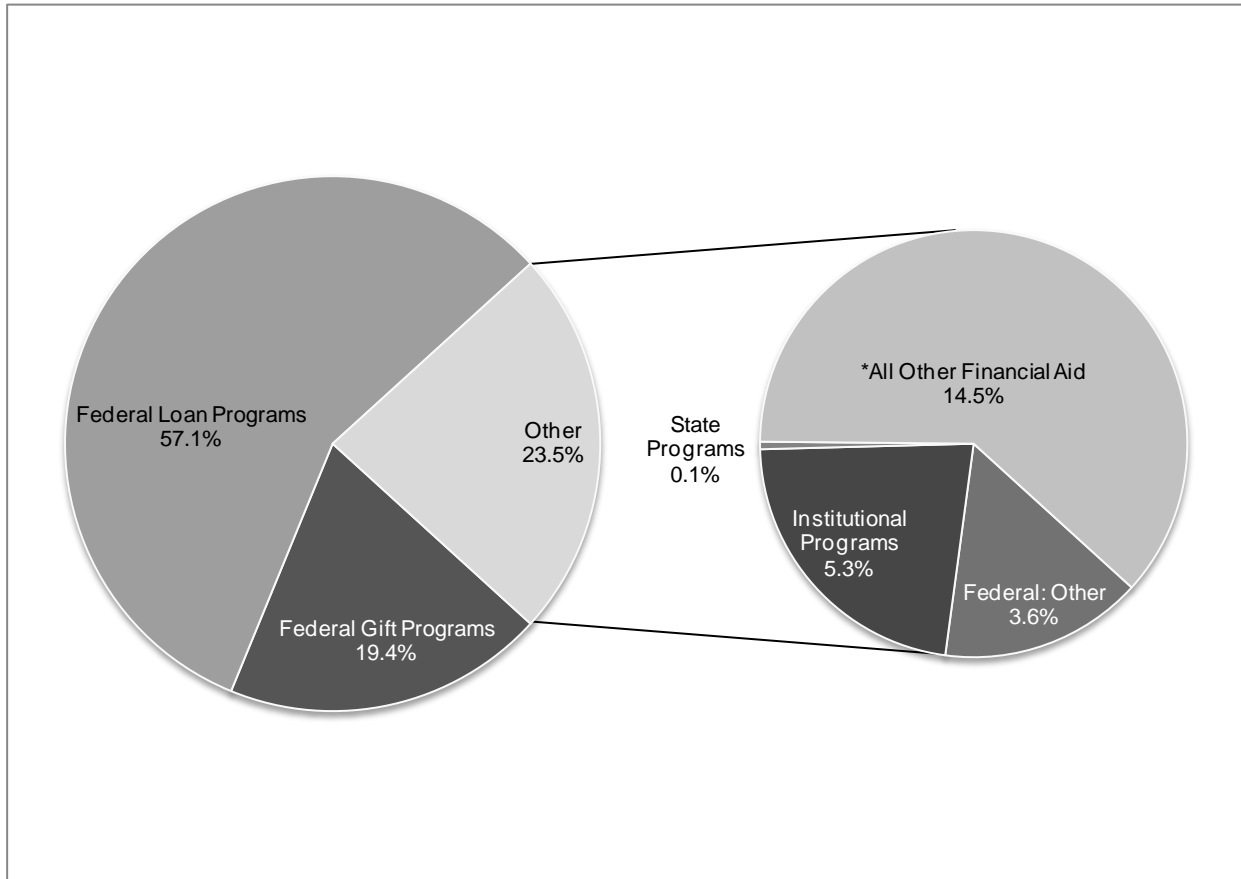

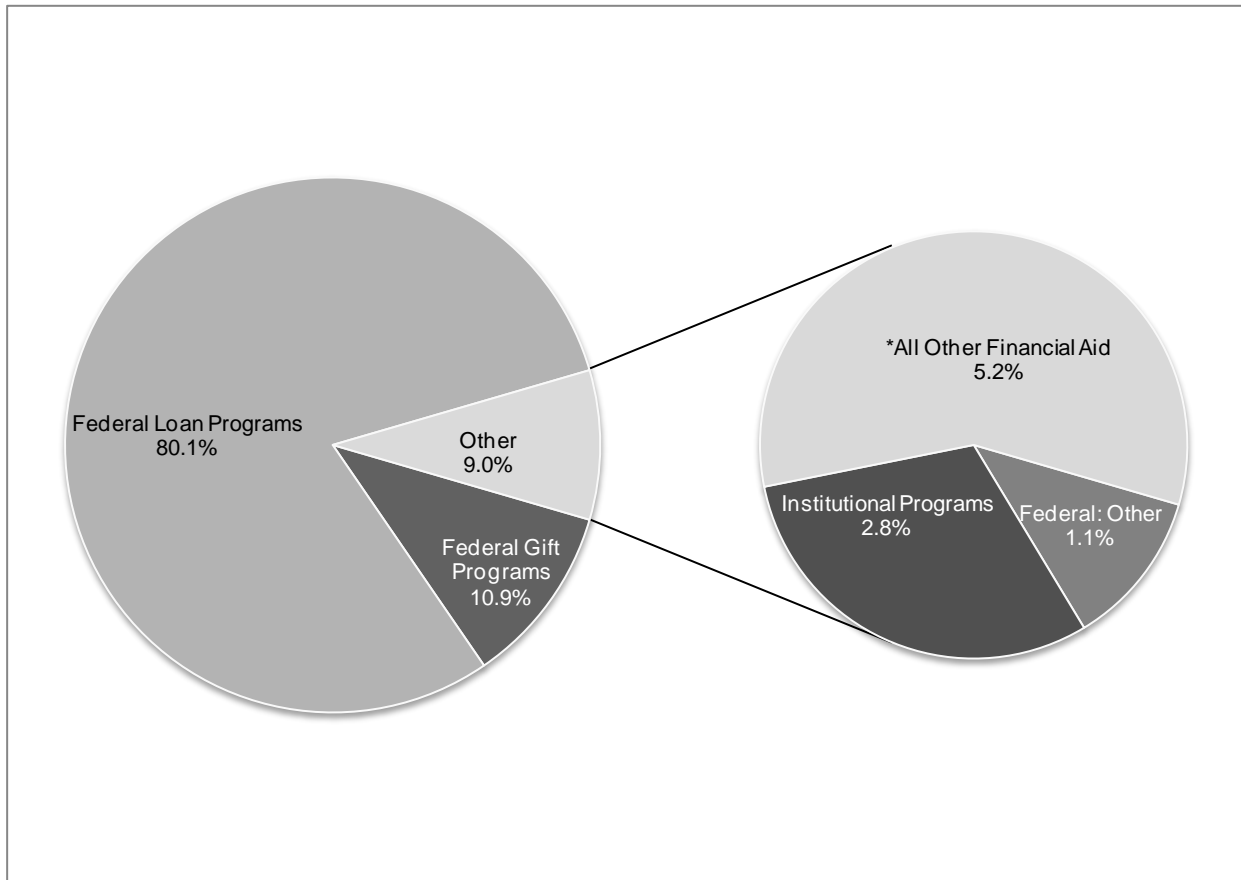

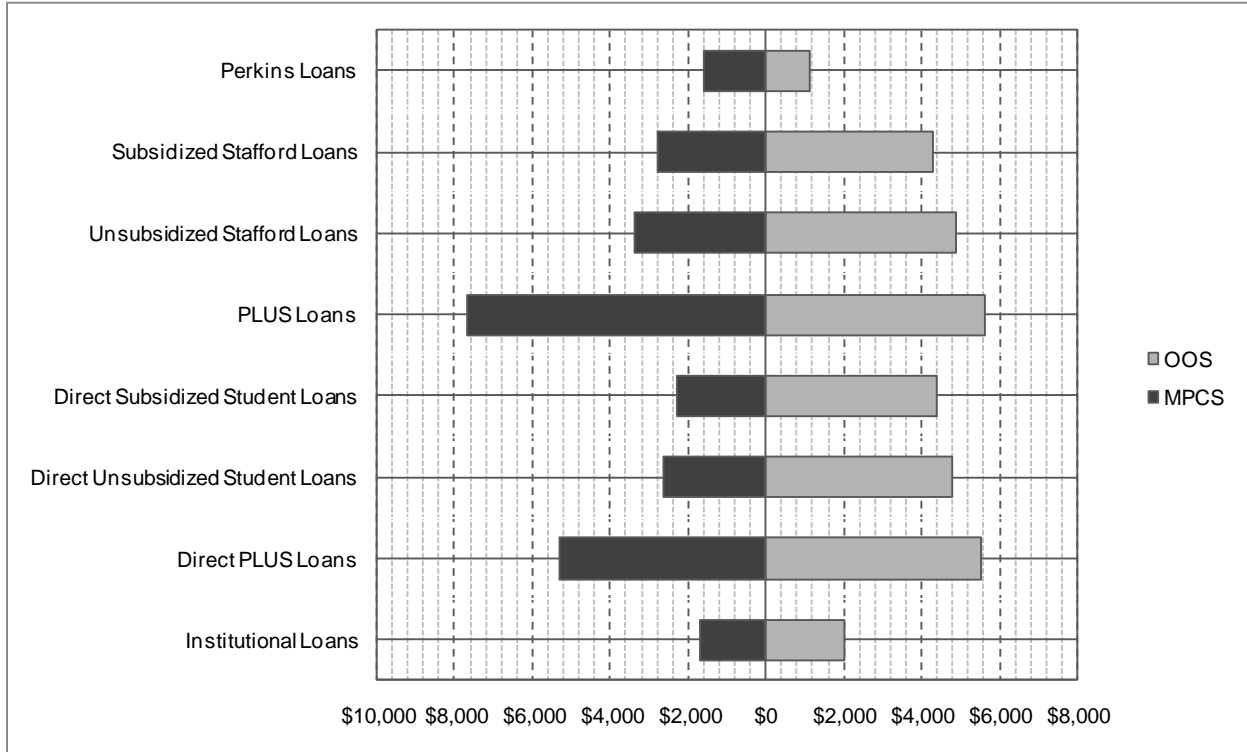

 Regionally Accredited Degree-Granting Institutions



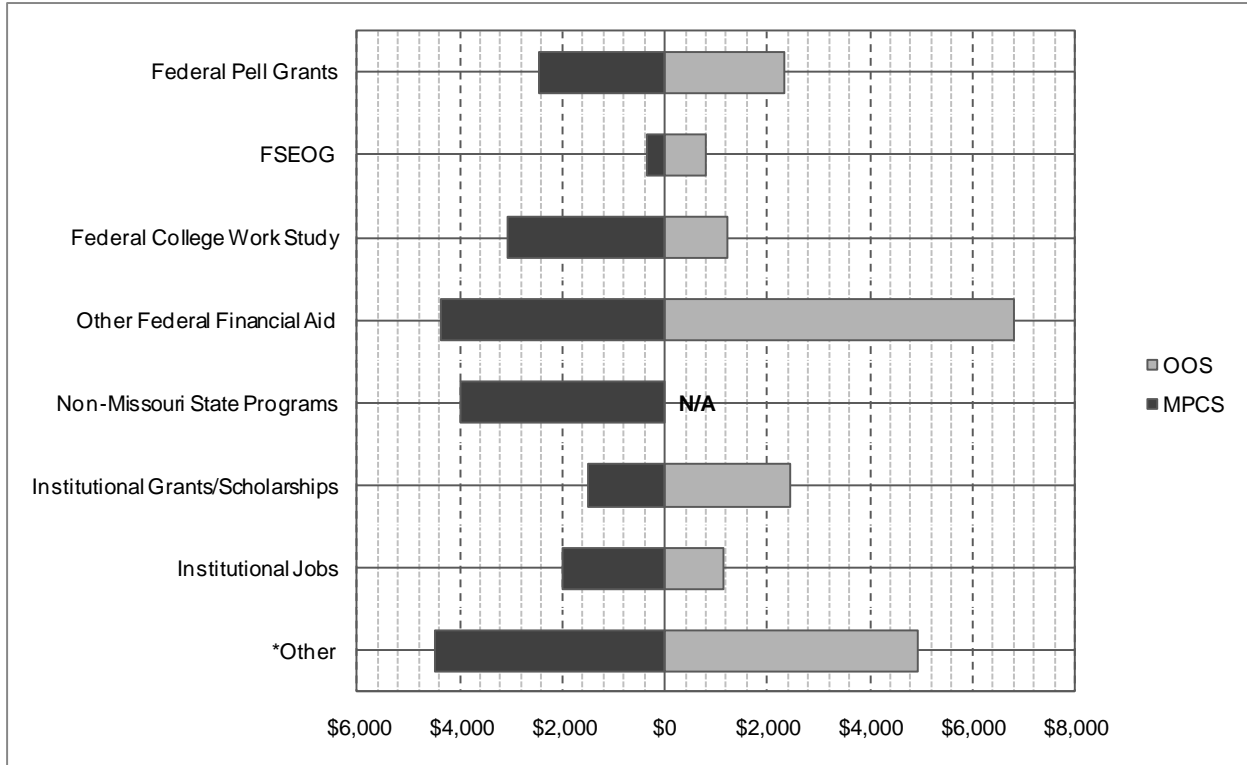
